



The theme of the Archdiocese 2025 Stewardship Campaign is "Your Own from Your Own," from the Divine Liturgy as we offer back to God that which He has given us. He receives our humble offering of bread and wine and returns them to us as His Body and Blood in Holy Communion.

So it is with our church, we often imagine only what is humanly possible. If we do our part in faith, God will lovingly return to us much more than we could ever imagine. This is the true meaning of "Your own from Your own." We will see our church, not as it is, but as it could be, with our humble gifts multiplied by God's generosity and love. With our faithful offering, we will see in our church as they did in the early Church, "...the Lord added to their number daily, those who were being saved" (Acts 2:47).

On Sunday November 17, 2024 we held our annual Stewardship Sunday asking parishioners to commit to the church with their treasure for 2025. Once again we had a wonderful response from parishioners pledging for 2025 and some fulfilling their 2025 commitment.

The Steward Committee and the Parish Council are happy to report that stewardship has grown again this past year and we are poised to hit budget and maybe surpass. We offer you all Pledged and Fulfilled Stewards "A BIG THANK YOU!" We have given to the church and in turn we have received an active vibrant community pastored by Father Panagiotis. That should be our goal to thrive and to have the resources to support all our ministries, whether it is GOYA, Kali Parea, Hope/Joy, and all our other ministries.

For everyone's knowledge and information, next year will be another challenging year for the church to sustain financial stability. Stewardship will account for 40% of the 2025 budgeted revenues. Our expenses have risen to over \$600,000. It wasn't too long ago that we were below \$450,000. This way we have a bit of a cushion to offset a down festival or an extra unexpected expense.



Fall Harvest Luncheon




